

RECYCLING AT THE TRANSFER STATION

1. SCRAP METAL

Household appliances, old pots and pans, sheet metal, empty open-ended clean metal barrels, grills, metal poles, lawnmowers without oil and gas, rototillers without oil and gas, any metal items. NOTE: Concrete must be removed from metal poles.

2. MOTOR OIL

ONLY motor oil from engines, no transmission fluid, brake cleaner. Antifreeze can be left with the attendants during the normal business hours of the transfer station.

3. BATTERIES

All lead acid batteries used in any engine, NiCad, alkaline, and rechargeable batteries.

4. LEAVES

Leaves only. This material is mulched for town residents and the mulch pile is located near the brush drop location at the end of Old Forge Road & Dividend Road - follow brush signs to loading area.

HOW: All leaves must be loose and emptied from their bags. See the attendants if you need assistance.

5. BRUSH

Brush must be no more than 4' long and 3" wide. Brush from tree pruning, storm or weather-related damage, or shrub removal is accepted. Due to space limitations, brush loads may be limited to one (1) pickup load per resident.

6. TIRES

Car tires, pickup tires only. **Tires with rims not accepted – must be separated.**

7. PAINT

Oil and Latex paint in labeled containers only. Must be at least half full to be recycled.

Otherwise, for both latex and oil-based paints go to paintcare.org to find local drop-off sites, i.e. Sherwin Williams or bring to your local [Household Hazardous Waste Collection Sites](#).

8. ELECTRONICS

Printers, Monitors, Televisions, Desktop Computers, Laptops, VCR & DVD Players, Copiers & Scanners, Fax Machines, Video Game Consoles, Modems, Keyboards, Computer Mice, Stereo Equipment, Telephones, Mobile phones, Cameras, Tablets & E-Books, Microwaves, other small appliances, computer components, anything electronic, anything with a cord.

9. PROPANE TANKS

Empty 20 lb. propane tanks for gas grills only.

10. FLUORESCENT BULBS

Fluorescent bulbs - any size and shape. **Ballasts** are no longer accepted at the Transfer Station. They must be brought to your local [Household Hazardous Waste Collection Sites](#).

11. TAG SALE ITEMS

Stuff accumulated over the years in your garage or basement - toys, dishes, bed frames, wooden tables, chairs, lawn furniture, lamps, etc.

12. FURNITURE

Couches, chairs, tables, bureaus, dressers, etc.

13. RUGS AND CARPET

Throw rugs, wall to wall carpeting, and padding (either rolled and tied with duct tape or rope, pieces should be no longer than 4' in length or cut up into pieces)

14. MATTRESSES AND BOX SPRINGS

Mattresses and Box Springs - Residents can also request a curbside pick-up by calling: 860-258-2766.

15. HOUSEHOLD TRASH

Kitchen and bathroom trash only.

16. STYROFOAM

Place in designated receptacle at Transfer Station.

17. FOOD WASTE

MERCURY PRODUCTS

NO HOUSEHOLD ITEMS SUCH AS THERMOMETERS OR THERMOSTATS THAT CONTAIN MERCURY ARE ALLOWED AT THE TRANSFER STATION.
