## TO ASSIST PEOPLE WITH MITIGATING PHYSICAL DISABILITIES

- ✓ Retrievals
- ✓ Open doors
- ✓ Turn lights on or off
- ✓ Assist handler getting dressed

## TO ASSIST PEOPLE WITH PSYCHOLOGICAL DISABILITIES

- ✓ Ensure a safe space
- ✓ Dog watches over veteran's back when back is exposed to the public.
- ✓ Dog will utilize its body to create a physical barrier to prevent the public from entering personal space.
- ✓ Dog will wake veteran up when veteran experiences a nightmare.
- ✓ Dog will lay down between veteran's legs for tactile grounding.
- ✓ Dog will seek assistance when veteran is unresponsive.
